
- We appreciate you! Thanks for being here!

For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat (Heb. 5:12).

The New Testament contains a wonderful store of information and is arranged as to give information to all. It is food for the soul. It contains milk for babes and strong meat for those more advanced in the Christian life. No other book so completely fits the needs of humanity.
