## “COMPARISONS MADE BY GOD: PART 3”

**It is better to dwell in the corner of a housetop, than in a house shared with a contentious woman.** Solomon had about 1,000 women. Some of them must have been contentious. “[*It is better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house*]” (Prov. 21:9; 25:24). This is not a blanket condemnation of the attitude of woman as a whole, but why are so many American women so unhappy when we are truly a blessed people? Solomon said, “[*Better [is] a dinner of herbs where love is, than a stalled ox and hatred therewith*]” (Prov. 15:17). He said, “[*It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman*]” (Prov. 21:19).

**A poor man is better than a liar.** Solomon said, “[*The desire of a man [is] his kindness: and a poor man [is] better than a liar*]” (Prov. 19:22). Kindness is a very desirable quality Christians should offer to others. “[*And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you*]” (Eph. 4:32). A poor man who is kind is better than one who is wealthy but untruthful. “[*Better [is] the poor that walketh in his uprightness, than [he that is] perverse [in his] ways, though he [be] rich*]” (Prov. 28:6).

There are many things that are “better.” Mary chose the good part (Luke 10:42). Let us do the same.

To become a Christian: **Hear** the word (Rom. 10:17), **Believe** in Jesus (John 8:24), **Repent** of sins (Acts 17:30-31), **Confess** Jesus as Lord (Rom. 10:9-10) and be **Baptized** into Christ (Gal. 3:26-27). “[*For a day in thy courts [is] better than a thousand. I had rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness*]” (Psa. 84:10).
