“LOVE”

Love. It is a small word that carries a big thought. Love is so important. Love is crucial. In Matthew 22:34-40, Jesus is approached by a lawyer, who asked Him a question. He asked this question “tempting” Jesus. In other words, he was not sincerely wanting to know the answer to his question. His question was, “Master, which is the great commandment in the law?” Jesus answered his question as He answered all questions by answering in the great possible way. He says, “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.”

By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.”

The love that we have for one another must be the kind of love that causes us to put others before ourselves and to even risk our own lives to help save others. I John 3:16 says, “Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.”
