## "WILL THE BIBLE BELT BUCKLE?" BY: KERRY DUKE

"Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil" (Eph. 6:11). Satan knows where the strongholds of Christianity are. That is why the Bible belt is under relentless attack.

Tennessee has been a bastion of the Truth for decades. The number of Christians and congregations in this area far exceeds that of many other states. This state has a rich history of preachers, schools, and journals dedicated to Bible teaching. But the situation is changing. It has changed. Mosques are appearing as the religion of Islam gets a free pass as a "peaceful religion" from the government and the media. Homosexuals are filing lawsuits to pressure lawmakers into legalizing same-sex marriages. Weak abortion restrictions have resulted in Tennessee ranking third in the nation for out-of-state abortions. The walls of spiritual Zion have clearly been breached.

Texas has a longstanding reputation for a bold commitment to the Truth and a fearless defense of it. But this fortress is also under siege. Satan is doing his best to shove unbelief and ungodliness down the throats of its citizens as he is trying to do in the rest of the Bible belt. He has also weakened Christians in these once biblically loyal states by watering down the Truth. Abilene Christian University, which was for years loyal to New Testament teaching, now has teachers who deny the verbal inspiration of the Bible and endorse women preachers and denominational fellowship.

Other sections of the Bible belt are under the same attack. The devil is aiming every weapon at his disposal at the Lord's church: materialism, immorality, apathy, envy, pride, and unbelief of every kind. If Satan can capture the areas where the church is the strongest, the rest will be his for the taking.

But don't dismiss or underestimate the number of loyal Christians in this part of the world or the resolve of their faith. There are still Christians in this part of the country with fire in their bones about the corruption of our society and the apostasy among God's people. I hear from some of these brothers and sisters on occasion. Some of you can say the same. The faithful are not in the majority, but these scattered pockets of Christians who are determined to stay with the Scriptures still have a presence and a voice in the midst of a crooked world. Like the apostles, they are "troubled on every side, yet not distressed...perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed" (II Cor. 4:8-9). Let us "be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might" (Eph. 6:10) and "fight the good fight of faith" (I Tim. 6:12).
