"WHY DO THE WICKED PROSPER?" BY: MALCOLM HILL

In Jeremiah 12 this same question is asked by the prophet. God talks with Jeremiah about this matter, but does not give an answer with regard to the question proposed by him. In essence, God told Jeremiah that he must be willing to face problems even greater than this if he would win the prize in the afterawhile (Jer. 12:1-6).

People are born with different abilities. Some people have more ability than others in that it is innate. This is seen quite clearly from the parable of the talents, as set forth in Matthew 25:14-30. Just because one is a child of God does not mean that he has more ability than he had before he became a follower of Christ. On the other hand, if he is a Christian he has the promise that God is with him and will bless him.

There can be no doubt that God is with all the righteous and has nothing to do with the wicked who have rebelled against Him. If a wicked man makes it, he makes it on his own and not with the assistance and help of God. We all realize that God sends the rain on the just and the unjust, and that the sun shines on them alike. But there is a sense in which God is with the righteous and not with the unrighteous.

We often judge success and failure by our standard and not by God's. Just because an individual has been blessed with this world's goods and has more possessions than does one of God's children, is by no means a sign that the child of God is a failure and is not successful. It should further be understood that God does not settle all of His accounts in this life. This can be seen very vividly from the story of Lazarus and the rich man, as is found in Luke 16:19-31. The rich man fared sumptuously every day in this life and Lazarus, the beggar, was in a sad condition. But when the two died the thing reversed. Lazarus was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom and the rich man died and in hell he lifted up his eyes, being in torments and cried for mercy and for help. Even though he had much more in the world than the poor beggar, we see him in eternity a beggar and poor and in a sad condition; while on the other hand we see the righteous beggar as he is in peace and joy and rest.

As you look at these two men, which one of them do you think was blessed most in the long run? We all can readily see that the beggar was truly blessed. We should learn from this that even though it seems that the wicked are blessed more than the righteous in this world, we should let God take care of all matters and do and live the best we know how. Everything then will take its proper place. Therefore we should not fret ourselves over evil doers.
