## “A PECULIAR PEOPLE” BY: BOBBY O’DELL

Peter called upon Christians to be a peculiar people when he wrote, “But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light” (I Peter 2:9). Notice now some characteristics of those who are peculiar.

Praying people: “Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints (Ephesians 6:18).”

Earnest people: “Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let *them* slip (Hebrews 2:1).”

Consecrated people: “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service (Romans 12:1).”

United people: “Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Ephesians 4:3).”

Loving people: “And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour (Ephesians 5:2).”

Influential people: “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven (Mathew 5:16).”

Active people: “Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord” (I Corinthians 15:58).”

Righteous people: “For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him (II Corinthians 5:21).”
