"GEARING UP FOR VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL 2012" BY: JASON GANN

I plan to address the importance of Vacation Bible School in an upcoming sermon, but since it is quickly approaching, I want to go ahead and address some matters pertaining to the grand concept of Vacation Bible School. Vacation Bible School is such an important time for any congregation. It is time during the "Summer Break" in which students are out of school to come together for a time of special study and devotion for God. Vacation Bible Schools are often framed differently depending on the congregation. It is certainly up to the leadership of a congregation as to how to frame a Vacation Bible School, but I am glad that we have one for all ages here.

II Timothy 2:15 says, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." We have a Scriptural obligation to study God's Word. We need to meditate on His Word day and night (Psalm 1). It is wonderful then that we have an avenue whereby we can come together to study His Word collectively. In Bible classes, we can learn from each other more about the riches of Christ. A sound teacher can help a student to learn more quickly than it took the teacher to learn the lesson. The teacher has put forth much effort in the lesson, thereby giving his or her students the opportunity to learn the principles set forth in the lesson more quickly. Those who teach know that a 30-40 minute lesson can take hours of preparation. Also, therefore we can say that students can learn God's Word more easily with the assistance of a teacher. Preachers and teachers expound (explain or interpret) Scriptures after much study, so they help people to learn God's Word more easily in a faster way. Nehemiah 8:8 says that teachers, "... read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading." Preachers and teachers are able to explain the Scriptures in such a way as to help us understand. This is why attending Bible classes is so important. While we can study the Word of God and learn much through our own individual study, we can learn even more through allowing others to teach us.

It is with these thoughts in mind that I ask you to start planning now to attend every session of our Vacation Bible School, which begins two weeks from today, lasting from June 24-28. The teachers are busily preparing. Let's be sure to come and study about the great book of Proverbs in this V. B. S.

There will be a door knocking campaign on Saturday, June 23. Be sure to come and be with us for this. Let us spread the news about our V. B. S.! Call people you know to let them know about this\endeavor. Let's prepare for a great Vacation Bible School!
