## SPREADING THE GOSPEL IN VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL BY: JASON GANN

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 says, "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates." Parents have a tremendous responsibility to train up children in the way that they should go (Proverbs 22:6). Ephesians 6:4 says, "And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord." Parents should do all within their abilities to raise up children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. A great way to do this is to teach children each day at home. Also, bringing children to the services of the church is especially important in teaching children the way in which they should go (Hebrews 10:25). 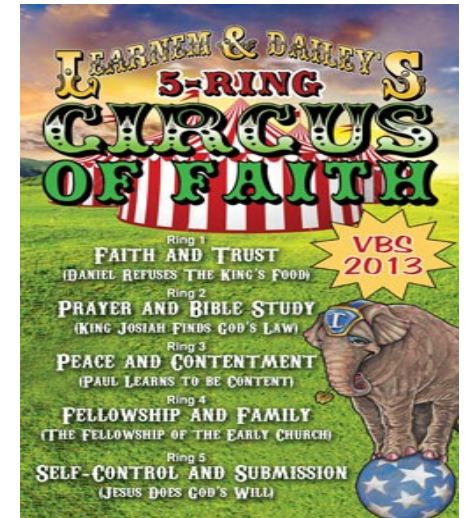
