In the early years of the reign of Josiah there were sodomites. They were so brazen that they built houses by the house of the Lord. Sodomy was not only against the law but was also a capital offence. How could this have happened? The leaders knew it was wrong but did nothing. Evidently this movement spread so gradually and stubbornly that it gained the power it had always wanted. There had been sodomites in the land years before in the time of Rehoboam (I Kings 14:24). By the time of Josiah they built houses near the temple of God and got away with it. Where were leaders with a backbone? They had turned a blind eye to this abomination. Some may have participated in it themselves and others may have been sympathetic to the gay community. Some of them may have had relatives or business associates who were involved. For whatever reason they stood by and let sodomites shove their disgusting behavior in face of the nation and of God Himself. These homosexuals were not satisfied with pursuing their lifestyle without being punished. They were not content to build their houses on the outskirts of Jerusalem and leave others alone. That is not how they operated then and it is not how they behave now. They were not happy until they were in people's faces demanding acceptance in the capital and the religious center of the nation! The government allowed them freedom to live as they pleased, but that freedom was not enough. They wanted power to control society and convert others to their sin against nature. The story of the men of Sodom shows that sinners want to dominate and not merely be equal. Leaders of the Boy Scouts have voted to allow gay members into their organization. The gay population was not satisfied with equal opportunity. They have the money and people to start their own scout organization, but that is not what they want. Like the sodomites in the Old Testament, they get in the face of people and demand acceptance. Scout leaders would not dream of letting girls camp with their boys, but they now allow the moral lunacy of young men with unnatural lusts sharing a tent with other boys. But this movement was never about reason. It is about one thing: perverted lust. The Scout leaders who voted for this change are like the leaders of Judah who turned a blind eye to sodomy. They have neither the moral conviction nor the courage to do what is right. This is another sad chapter in the history of a nation that once honored the law of God but now is rotting from within because few people are brave enough to stand. Sodomites had their way until Josiah broke down their houses (II Kings 23:7). Thank God we have some people left who have the courage to stand up to sinful men today.
