“CHRIST-LIKE LIVING”

Jesus the Christ is our great example. We are to follow His example in all things (cf. 1 Pet. 2:21). A Biblical example of one who truly followed this perfect example is that of the apostle Paul. In writing to the church at Corinth, he admonished the brethren there to “be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ” (11:1). That is, Paul admonished the Corinthians not to follow him personally but rather follow his example of imitating Christ in his life. In writing to the church at Philippi, Paul had this to say: “Brethren, be followers together of me” (4:17). Again, this is simply saying the same thing written to the Corinthians only in different terms: follow my example of Christ like living. Paul goes on to include the example of all who live Christ like when he adds: “and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.” How did Paul imitate Christ in living Christ like and thus how can we do the same thing? Consider this list of attributes seen in the life of Jesus or ascribed to Jesus by inspired men of old that ought to characterize Christians.

1. Holy (Acts 4:27—“the holy child; 2:27—“thine Holy One”)
2. Without guile (1 Pet. 2:22),
3. Spotless (1 Pet. 1:19), 4. Sinless (2 Cor. 5:21; Heb. 4:15),
5. Overcome temptation (Matt. 4:1-10), 6. Obedient in all things (Jn. 15:10),
7. Zealous (Lk. 2:49), 8. Meek (Matt. 11:29),
9. Lowly in heart (Matt. 11:29), 10. Merciful (Heb. 2:17),
11. Patient (Matt. 27:14), 12. Long suffering (1 Tim. 1:16),
13. Compassionate (Matt. 15:32), 14. Benevolent (Matt. 4:23-24),
15. Loving (Jn. 13:1), 16. Selfless (Matt. 8:20),
17. Humble (Lk. 22:27),
18. Steadfastly fixed in living, teaching and defending the truth (Jn. 14:6)
19. Fearless (Matt. 21:12,13), 20. Forgiving (Lk. 23:34)
21. Pure (1 Jn. 3:3)

Every single one of these characteristics listed were manifested in the life of the apostle Paul. They are clearly evidenced when one makes an in-depth study of the life of Paul. His life truly imitated the life that Christ lived while on this earth. It is this kind of living that enabled him to endure persecution and look forward to the heavenly home (2 Tim. 4:6-8). It is this same kind of living that can enable us to endure all things and look forward to the heavenly home. The catch is we have to live the life not just talk the talk (cf. Acts 1:1). It is one thing to say we must imitate Christ but another thing completely to do such. If we do not live Christ like in this life then death will not be gain for us, however if we do live Christ like then death will be gain for us just as it was for Paul (Phil. 1:21). Christ has shown us the way (Jn. 14:6), He has given us His example to follow (1 Pet. 2:21), it is now up to us to determine to follow the way His footsteps have trod by walking in the example He set for us and commands for us to follow.
