Dear brothers in Christ,

Fond greetings to you in our loving and living name of Father and Lord Jesus Christ. May the spirit of God and His grace and peace be with you. I feel that it is great opportunity to write and introduce my self to you. I am A. Ravi , 32 years old, graduate in Biblical studies. I have been working as an evangelist in Nereducharla area, Nalgonda district of A.P. state in India. I preach for 3 congregations and preaching the gospel at different places in our province. We the 15 dedicated gospel preachers are working cooperatively at various places. This is to bring to your kind notice that, the areas where we are working the people are unknown about the real God. The 98% people are worshipping the idols. The people are in great need of hungry to listening the God’s message. When we delivering the message of crucified and raisen Christ, people are listening carefully and are interesting to know more about Christ and the salvation in Him. In period they are obeying the gospel in immersion. Thus we are able to see the salvation of many precious souls in every month. We thank God for the power of the gospel of Christ. It is the vast situation at number of unevangelised vil-lages and towns in our province. We are praying at Lord’s feet and working hard to win the lost. We believe that the preaching of the gospel is a matter of life and death and that the gospel must be preached even in the most remote and religiously inaccessible locations on the surface of the earth, because it is God’s power giving salvation to all that believe. Hence, we have burning hearts to fulfill the great commission of Lord Christ. By the cause of poverty in our country(80% of people) and of our individual poverty we are unable to reach the places in time. And we are unable to give the daily bread to our families as we endeavoring to spread more gospel to the lost as full time gospel workers in the Lord’s vine-yard. Physically we are naked people. It is our situation. Real situation. Work is more. No one is there behind us, except God. We stand in need of some one’s love and care on this earth. We are praying and seeking for brothers like Gaius of Romans 16:23. By the grace of God, we have come to know about your great mission work as a loving family of God for the people in US and abroad to help and encourage the servants of God around the world. Brother we are waiting out side of your walls. If you feel led by the Lord to help us we will be so grateful. Please pray. Your prayers will serve as a corner stone to the success of the endeavor. Please extend your helping hand to us to do more effective and productive work
