"Is Your Top Priority to Love God With All of Your Being?: Part 5" By: Marvin L. Weir

[Note: This is the conclusion of this five-part article. The fourth part, included in the January 7th edition of the bulletin, is included again below, with new information not published in this bulletin yet, so that you can see the complete list of 11 points together below.]

To make loving God with all our being our top priority, provides the answer to other so-called problems. It is the answer for:

- 1. Forsaking the assembling of ourselves together (Heb. 10:25).
- 2. Failure to give cheerfully and as prospered (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 9:6-7).
- 3. Failure to study and grow in knowledge of the Word of God (2 Peter 3:18).
- 4. Failure to be the salt of the earth and light of the world (Matt. 5:13-16).
- 5. Failure to flee fornication and all other immorality (1 Cor. 6:18).
- 6. Failure to flee from idolatry (1 Cor. 10:14).
- 7. Failure to worship "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24).
- 8. Failure to obey the Gospel (Rom. 1:16; 2 Thess. 1:7-9).
- 9. Failure to "fight the good fight of faith" (1 Tim. 6:12).
- 10. Failure to defend the Gospel (Phil. 1:16).
- 11. Failure to "be faithful unto death" (Rev. 1:10).

OLD TESTAMENT WORTHIES WHO HAD A PROPER TOP PRIORITY!

Abraham —who by faith "...when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went" (<u>Heb. 11:8</u>). He left his family, friends, land, and home behind in order to put God first and honor Him (<u>Gen. 12:1</u>).

Noah —who resisted the majority and was a "preacher of righteousness" (<u>2 Peter 2:5</u>). He built the ark according to God's instructions (<u>Gen. 6:14ff</u>). It is said of him, "Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he" (<u>Gen. 6:22</u>).

Joshua and Caleb —who found themselves a minority voice but nonetheless stood firm in following God (Num. 14:6-10). As a result of following God, Joshua and Caleb were the only two above 20 years of age that were permitted to enter the promised land.

One who does not love God with all his heart, soul, mind and strength (<u>Mark 12:30</u>), will not put God first in his life and will lose his soul. A Christian must not forget Paul's plea to the church at Colosse, "Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God" (<u>Col. 3:2-3</u>). One's top priority will determine the eternal state of his soul!
