"THE COLLECTION - WHAT?: PART 1" BY: KERRY DUKE

I grew up in a Southern Baptist church. We went to Sunday school and attended worship regularly. I have clear childhood memories of those services. The people were kind and my Bible class teachers were morally upright. Though I can't recall a lot of what the preachers said, I remember the piano, the altar call, the testimonials and a few times shouting which scared me as a young child. What I don't remember much was the Lord's Supper. I saw it so seldom that it didn't make much of an impression on my young mind. I can't remember if it was observed once, twice or several times a year. All I knew was that they were passing out little pieces of crackers and tiny cups of juice and I didn't get

any. We passed collection plates every Sunday. I saw what that was about, but the little bites of food were a mystery. Because I rarely saw it, I don't remember much about it. At the time I didn't understand what it was or why it was done. I certainly didn't get the idea that it was all that important.

Later I learned what the Bible says about communion. Acts 20:7 says the disciples came together on the first day of the week for the very purpose of having the Lord's Supper.
