2. Confidence that you can understand the Bible (John 8:32). *(Note: Continued on Page 3)*



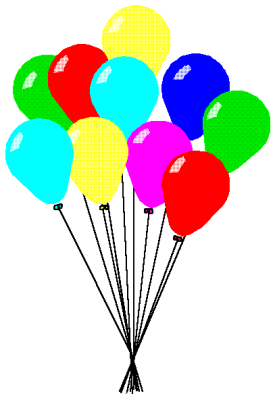
