"OPPORTUNITIES TO SPREAD THE GOSPEL" BY: JASON GANN

I begin this article thinking with a verse at the forefront of my mind and that verse is, "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin." Now, sin is a serious thing. Sin is the transgression of the Law of God (I John 3:4). It is something that we should not do. Our Creator has given unto life, breath, and all things (Acts 17:25). The fact that we can experience existence, have our physical necessities and have all of our spiritual necessities is due to the fact that our Creator gave them to us (Matthew 5:45, Ephesians 1:3). He even gave unto us His Son to die in our stead (John 3:16). The wages of sin is death and that is what all of us deserve for all, except for Christ, who reached accountability have fallen short of the glory of God. - Teaching in home Bible studies
- Talking to people about Christ in your workplace, in stores, and in various other places
- Speaking Christ unto others in visiting them at the hospitals and nursing homes
- Helping with Bible Correspondence Courses
- Teaching by example through preparing or furnishing food to the sick and shut-ins, fruit basket
 making, preparing food for fellowship meals, bringing food for the pantry, providing needs of
 widows and orphans (Matthew 25:31-46)
