"THROUGH THE HEBREW NATION" BY: JASON GANN

Through the Hebrew nation, Jesus would come to the earth, according to Genesis 22:18, as God told the Hebrew Patriarch, "And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice." God protected the faithful remnant of Israel and He used Joseph to keep the Hebrews alive when a famine reached the whole world. He was sold into Egyptian slavery by some jealous brothers, but God used that situation, working behind the scenes to cause Joseph to ascend from being a slave to being second in command over Egypt in the temporal government. Genesis 39:2 says, "And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian."

In Genesis 45:5-9, Joseph recognized God's providence in helping him in Egypt, by saying to his brothers when they realized their guilt, :Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life. For these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest. And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance. So now it was not you that sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt. Haste ye, and go up to my father, and say unto him, Thus saith thy son Joseph, God hath made me lord of all Egypt: come down unto me, tarry not:"

The Hebrews would be led forth from Egypt by Moses out of Egypt and by Joshua into the promised land. God would guide Prophets to pen the Old Testament, containing many prophecies about Jesus, and helping the ancient world to know of the coming Savior. During the days of the Roman Empire, Christ came and this was a time of peace for Canaan. God worked through His general providence to help make sure that Jesus came to the world at the perfect time. He also worked through His specific providence to help Joseph and many faithful along the way. Seeing then, that God worked through His general providence, let us understand that He still does so through maintaining this earth physically and by raising up and sitting down leaders over nations.
