## “A HASTY CONCLUSION: PART 1” BY: HARDEMAN NICHOLS

King David must have known all kinds, from the rich and famous to the poor peasant, those with greed for power and the contented servant with his family. He had seen them all. But there was one trait, ugly and shameful, that cut across all cultural lines and was found among all kinds of people. So universal was that despicable practice that David almost lost his confidence in everyone. He confided, “I said in my haste, All men are liars” (Psa. 116:11).

Jeremiah would have shouted “Amen!” if he had lived in David’s time. The nation of Judah had become so adept at lying and deceit that he lamented, “And they bend their tongues like their bow for lies: but they are not valiant for the truth upon the earth;...Take ye heed every one of his neighbour, and trust ye not in any brother: for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbour will walk with slanders. And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity” (Jer. 9:3-5). In exasperation, you sigh, “Who then, can be trusted?”

Lying is so pandemic that it is tempting to conclude that everyone is doing it. Consider some of the many categories of liars.

**Pernicious liars.** These “make up” reproaches and spread them for advantage or to harm. Of these, God warns: “Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off” (Psa. 101:5).

**Social liars.** This is often excused as “polite” lying. One flatters “Your dress is beautiful” while thinking it really is atrocious. Mothers sometime teach their children to do this. When they do not want to talk to someone, they just have the child say, “She’s not home.”
