“THINGS TO CONSIDER”

The Christian Life

Jesus quoted from the writings of Moses when He said, “It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God” (Mat. 4:4). Jesus did not mean to convey the idea that man lives his physical life by the Word of God. The tempter had asked Jesus to turn stones into bread. Jesus had fasted for forty days and nights and was hungry. Jesus quoted the language of Moses to show that there is a more important life to live than the physical. Spiritual life is more important than physical life. Under the dispensation of Christ, the better life is the Christian life.

C. W. Post wrote a small booklet titled How to Live a Hundred Years, but it was a failure, for Post died when he was seventy. But the Word of God is dependable and sure. Man can live a spiritual life if he lives by the Word of God. However, he must live by every Word of God—not some of them. Many spiritual fatalities are due to partial obedience.

Paul says, “For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die” (Rom. 8:13). By this, Paul means that one who lives only for material things dies spiritually. The Laodiceans thought they were good Christians because they prospered physically. They said they were rich, increased with goods, and needed nothing.

All who live the Christian life follow the same rule—“Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing” (Phi. 3:16). The rule is the Word of God. When men walk by the same religious rule, they do the same things. They worship God the same way. They do what the Lord commands them to do and do nothing that is not commanded.
