

"LOOKING BACK: PART 2" BY: JASON GANN

In the September 10th edition of the *Campaign Courier*, we looked at reasons that it is good to look back. Those reasons include the following. It is good to look back to the past to learn the good examples to be like them and to learn from the bad examples to not be like them. It is good to look to the past to learn from our mistakes, so that we do not make them again. It is good look to the past to remember precious memories. It is good to rely on knowledge that we learned from the past. Today, we will look at some additional reasons it is good to look back. Certainly, God has blessed us with memories to do so.

We must remember the poor and humble, and those in need. Hebrews 13:16 says "But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased."

It is good to remember from the past who our enemies are, lest we forget who we are fighting in the good fight of faith. Psalm 74:23 says, "Forget not the voice of thine enemies: the tumult of those that rise up against thee increaseth continually." I Timothy 6:12 says, "Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses." We also need to remember to pray for them. Matthew 5:44 says, "But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;".

It is good to remember our trials, so that we will be stronger and know that we can overcome with God's Help. James 1:3-4 says, "Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing."

It is good to remember the past to remember to whom to give honor.

Romans 13:7 says that we are to give, "honour to whom honour." Encouragement goes a long way.

It is good to reflect upon the past to learn about all of our blessings. Psalm 145:7 says, "They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness."
