"THE SOLDIER, THE ATHLETE, AND THE FARMER" BY: JASON GANN

II Peter 1:10 says, "Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:". As Christians, we must be totally obedient to the Father for no sin can enter into Heaven (Hebrews 5:9, James 2:10, and Revelation 21:27). We must work diligently to be conformed into the Image of Christ, while putting God First as Christ did (Romans 8:29, Matthew 6:33). The Apostle Paul counseled young Timothy to endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ, as he does to each of us, by inspiration of God to consider what he says, asking that the Lord give understanding in all things.
