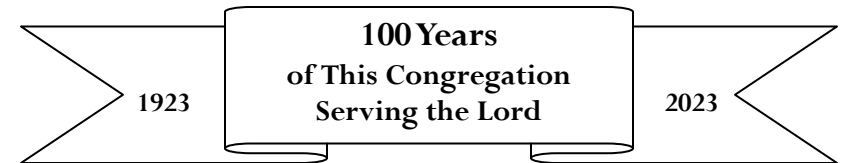

“LOOKING FORWARD: PART 1”

In the September 10th and October 8th editions of the *Campaign Courier*, we looked at reasons that it is good to look back. These are times that we must look back. Now, let us look at times we must look back, but rather forward.

Now, I will tell you what is not good to remember from the past and that is your sins. You must move on from these. It is not good to dwell on the sinful things you have done in the past, once you have repented, because God has forgiven you and you must forgive yourself. It is not good to look back at the sinful ways in which you obtained temporary pleasure in the past, and long for them with desire. It is good not good to look back at the sins of others, for which they have repented, and hold them against them. My friends, these are times that we must not look back, but rather, we must look forward.

Genesis 19:15-17 says, “And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city. And while he lingered, the men laid hold upon his hand, and upon the hand of his wife, and upon the hand of his two daughters; the LORD being merciful unto him: and they brought him forth, and set him without the city. And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.” This was a situation where they were not to look back. If they looked back, they might not get out of the sinful situation.

In verses 18 through 22, we are told, “And Lot said unto them, Oh, not so, my Lord: Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die: Behold now, this city is near to flee unto, and it is a little one: Oh, let me escape, thither, (is it not a little one?) and my soul shall live. And he said unto him, See, I have accepted thee concerning this thing also, that I will not overthrow this city, for the which thou hast spoken. Haste thee, escape thither; for I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither. Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar. The instructions were clear. They were to get out, and not look back.

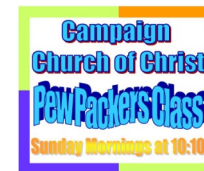
Verses 23 through 26 say, “The sun was risen upon the earth when Lot entered into Zoar. Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven; And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground. But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.” We see what happened when Lot’s wife looked back! Do not dwell on the sinful things you have done in the past after you have repented!
