The Apostle Paul by inspiration of the Holy Spirit says in Titus 3:1-2, "Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men." Here we are told about how we should relate to those in authority. We also see how we are to relate toward all.
