## "THE WONDERFUL PLAN OF SALVATION" BY: JASON GANN

God has revealed unto mankind the wonderful Plan of Salvation. This is how people become Christians and are added to the Lord's church (Acts 2:47). Remember that the church of Christ is the one body in which salvation is found (Romans 16:16, Ephesians 4:4, Ephesians 5:23).

Hearing God's Word is necessary. Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God." You need to hear the Word of God.

Faith is necessary. Mark 16:16 says, "He that believe h and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believe h not shall be damned." You need to believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Repentance is necessary. II Peter 3:9 says, "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." You need to repent and thus turn from your sins and start living in a right way.

Confession of Christ is necessary. In Matthew 10:32, Jesus Christ tells us, "Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven." You need to confess that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Baptism is necessary. In Acts 2:38, those who are not Christians are told to, "Repent and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." You need to be baptized or immersed in water in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Upon completing all of these simple steps, you will be a Christian.

Faithfulness is necessary. In Revelation 2:10, Christ tells us, ". . . be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life." You must live the faithful Christian life to be pleasing to God and make Heaven your home!
