In the Lord's kingdom, there is no room for slothfulness, and there is never an excuse for a negative attitude!

Even when circumstances do not permit one to be as physically involved as he or she would like, one's enthusiasm and attitude ought to still be on the positive side.

If you have been spasmodic in your Christianity, here is a message from the one who died for you:

"Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works" (Rev. 2:5).


"Does This Describe You?" BY: DAVID SAIN
