“PATTERNS OF THANKFULNESS”

Our Ultimate Example, Jesus Christ, shows us a pattern of thankfulness. We see Him thanking God in Matthew Chapter 11, verse 25, where He says, “At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.” We see Him thanking God in Mark Chapter 8, verse 6, where we read, “And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before them; and they did set them before the people.” Just prior to the raising of Lazarus, we read in John Chapter 11, verse 41, “Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.”

Throughout Holy Writ, we can find many other examples of those who were thankful. Truly, the people of God should be thankful people, grateful people. In Psalm 100, we read of words of praise from the mouth of David, “Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.” David was grateful.

After being forbidden from praying by the law of the land for 30 days, we read in Daniel Chapter 6, verse 10, “Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.” Daniel was grateful.

We read in Luke 1, verses 46 through 55, we read how grateful hearts behave as Mary says, “And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord, And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour. For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is his name. And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation. He hath shewed strength with his arm; he hath scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. He hath put down the mighty from their seats, and exalted them of low degree. He hath filled the hungry with good things; and the rich he hath sent empty away. He hath holpen his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy; As he spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed for ever.”

Let us follow these examples! Let us be thankful! Let us be patterns of thankfulness each and every day!
