"PUT AWAY AND REPLACE" BY: JASON GANN

Ephesians Chapter 4, verses 31 and 32, followed by Ephesians Chapter 5, verses 1 and 2, state, "Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour." In these verses, we have an exhortation from God through Paul unto the church at Ephesus as well as Christians in all places and at all times. In this exhortation we are called by the Gospel to be followers of God. The word, "followers," here means "imitators." An "imitator" follows the example of another, in this case, our Creator, God. Who better to imitate than God Himself, who created us? There is no better one to imitate for He has given unto us life, breath, and all things (Acts 17:25). We are created in His Image (Genesis 1:27). He took on flesh and provided unto us the Perfect Example that we should follow in His steps (I Peter 2:21-24).

If we are to imitate Christ and our Heavenly Father, we must remove some things if they are in our lives, and replace them with other things. We must remove bitterness, that is the way of thinking that retains unrighteously angry feelings. This is the kind of attitude that involves having a "chip on one's shoulder," ready to take offense. It is the frame of mind that lacks self-control. Bitterness must be removed, along with wrath and anger. "Wrath" entails an outburst of resentment and "anger" entails getting mad about that which is not wrong. In other words, having anger by making "a mountain out of a molehill." "Clamor" is a loud outburst of an angry man involving harshness. "Railing" entails "insults." All of these are to be put away from us. All of these sins are manifestations of malice, yet we are told that all malice must be removed. All evil thinking must be removed.

Bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, railing, and all malice should be replaced with kindness, tenderheartedness, forgiveness, and love. We must then be willing to put others before ourselves. We must be willing to be compassionate and merciful, considering that mortal men and mortal women are not sinlessly perfect, but that as God in Christ forgave us, we, too, must forgive. When people repent, we must forgive (Luke 17:3).

Then, as God forgives, we must imitate His Example, and forgive. We must look to our God as our Heavenly Father, and emulate as His children, these characteristics, walking in love, that is walking in a way to benefit others. Christ gave up His Life out of love for us. He gave His Life an offering for us. We must be willing to love each other as brothers and sisters more than our own lives (I John 3:16). Let us follow our God as His children! Let us imitate Him! Let us love Him and each other!
