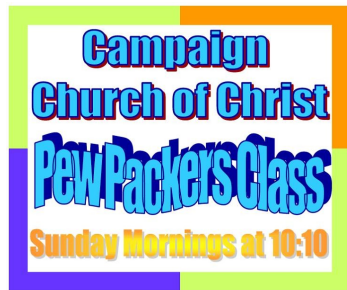

“LOOKING FORWARD: PART 4”

In the September 10th and October 8th editions of the Campaign Courier, we looked at reasons that it is good to look back. These are times that we must look back. In the November 12th, December 10th, and January 14th editions of the Campaign Courier, we looked at reasons we should look forward. Below is the conclusion of the series of articles on the subject of “Looking Forward.”

II Corinthians 5:17 says, “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.” Gospel obedience changes your life, your outlook, and the priorities that you have. A person who obeys the Gospel cannot continue to live the old life of sin. When a person obeys the Gospel, he or she is changed. The person’s outward looks are different, but rather, the change occurs on the inside.

If you have not yet become a new creature, then now is the time. It is the time for you to look forward. You must obey the Gospel in order to have the best life here and the best life in eternity. Christ says in John 10:10, “The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.” Also, eternal happiness awaits you in Heaven through obedience for we are told in Hebrews 5:9 that Christ is the “. . .the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;. . .” Revelation 21:4 says about Heaven, “And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.” Heaven awaits the faithful. Hell awaits the unfaithful. Matthew 25:46 says, “And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.”

II Thessalonians 1:8-10 says, “In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.”

Put the sins of your past behind you! Obey the Gospel through hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17), believing Jesus Christ is the Son of God (Mark 16:16), repenting of sins (Acts 17:30-31), confessing Jesus Christ is the Son of God (Matthew 10:32), and by being baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). Then, live faithfully unto death (Revelation 2:10).

If you have fallen away as a child of God, come back through repentance of sins (Acts 8:22), confession of sins (I John 1:9), and prayer (Acts 8:22). You can have forgiveness. Look forward. Go forward. Press toward Heaven!
