"IN THE BEGINNING" BY: JASON GANN

Genesis and all of the Holy Bible begins with the words, "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth." It thus is as Proverbs 3:19 says, "The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens." The Holy Bible begins with God. God creates time and space here. It creates all of the universe, and He does so in 6 days. We see the creative work of God in Chapter 1.

Verses 3 and 5 say, "And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day." This is how each of these days went from day 1 through 5, God speaks, looks at His creation, and sees that it is good. As day 2 approaches, God creates the atmosphere that divides the water above from the water below. Truly, a much more tropical earth then. The third day, he creates the seas and the dry land, along with the grass, herb yielding seed, and fruit tree yielding fruit, whose seed is in itself. The plant life has capabilities to reproduce after its kind. On the fourth day, God divides the day and the night. He creates the sun, moon, and the stars. On the fifth day, moving creatures and flying animals are created along with water animals.

Then, on the sixth day, God creates the land animals, then man. In verses 26 through 28, we are told, "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth." God gives the plantlife to man to eat, then through speaking creative power, He looks back upon His creation and now pronounces, "it was very good."
