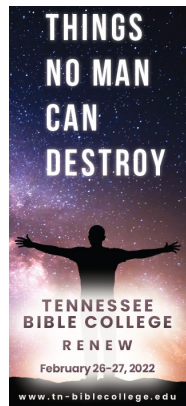

“WILL YOU WALK THROUGH THE GREAT DOORS?”

In I Corinthians 16:9, Paul the Apostle says, “For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and there are many adversaries.” He was planning to come to the brothers and sisters at Corinth. He was passing through Macedonia. He planned to stay there with them for the winter that they might bring him on his journey wherever he went. He would not see them for a while, but he did plan to stay a while with them, if the Lord permitted this. He would stay at Ephesus until Pentecost he has said by inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and it is after this that he speaks of a great door. You see, he recognized any time that he had to speak God’s Word that this was a great door (Acts 14:27, II Corinthians 2:12-13, Colossians 4:2-3). Paul wanted to stay at Ephesus, because there was a good opening for preaching the Gospel.

Paul was ready to defend the Gospel against the adversaries. He would strengthen the faith of those who were converted. He recognized the opportunity to spread the Gospel as a great door.

Do we see our opportunities to spread the Word of God in the same way? Do we view them as a great door? We should never be ashamed of Christ and His Word (Matthew 10:32). We should be willing to spread the Gospel with every opportunity (Matthew 28:18-20). We must be set to defend the Gospel (Jude 3). There are many doors before us to do this. Let us view them as openings. Let us walk through them. Now, the question is, “Will you walk through the great doors?”
