In I Corinthians 16:9, Paul the Apostle says, "For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and there are many adversaries." He was planning to come to the brothers and sisters at Corinth. He was passing through Macedonia. He planned to stay there with them for the winter that they might bring him on his journey wherever he went. He would not see them for a while, but he did plan to stay a while with them, if the Lord permitted this. He would stay at Ephesus until Pentecost he has said by inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and it is after this that he
