# “GIVING AND RECEIVING: PART 2”

We must remember that it is more blessed to be a servant than it is to receive service. “For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many” (Mark 10:45). To turn a phrase a little differently than it is normally quoted, we should ask not what the church can give us but what we can give the church. We should ask not what our brother or sister can give unto us but rather what can we give unto them. We should not only ask what God can give us but focus on what we can give the Lord.

Let us zero in on some acts of giving we can practice on a regular basis.

1. I can give my time to God by attending every service, reading my Bible daily, praying regularly and telling others about the gospel (Heb. 10:25; Mat. 6:33; 1 Tim. 4:13; 2 Tim. 2:15; Col. 4:2; 2 Tim. 2:2).
2. I can give the church my support by giving my time to build up it’s program of service. Faith without works is dead (Jam. 2:17) and I have been created in Christ Jesus unto good works (Eph. 2:10). My responsibility is to be steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord (1 Cor. 15:58). I can serve by giving my time to go out and visit and encourage those who are in need both physically and spiritually. I can build up the educational program by giving my time to teach God’s Word. I can give in every area of work where assistance is needed.
3. I can give my brother and sisters a shoulder to lean on in time of trial (1 Cor. 12:25; Rom. 12:15). I can give them a pat on the back in time of joy (Rom. 12:15).
4. I can give the widowed and lonely some company (Jam. 1:27; 1 The. 5:14).
5. I can give my family the attention it deserves by being there for my spouse and children (Deu. 6:6ff; Eph. 5:25ff).

The list could literally go on and on. The marvelous truth about giving is that it blesses the giver with happiness and joy. Jesus gave when He washed the disciples feet. He admonished His disciples to perform similar acts of giving service. “If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them” (John 13:17). What will you give today?
