"WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHRISTIAN?: PART 2" BY: SIDNEY WHITE

Third, **becoming a Christian means that one enters a new life.** One is raised from the waters of baptism to "walk in newness of life" (Rom. 6:3-4). This new life may be more difficult for some because of their past life. The new life no doubt was a much easier adjustment for one like Cornelius (Acts 10:1-6) than it would have been for those in Corinth (1 Cor. 6:9-11). This new life may result in persecution, but recognizing the value of this new life we will endure (Mat. 10:22; 1 Cor. 10:13; Phi. 4:13).

Fourth, **becoming a Christian means that we now have new objects of affection.** We give up our love for the world (1 John 2:15-17). We mortify (put to death) our desire for the ways of the flesh (Col. 3:1ff). We now love God (Mat. 22:37) more than anything else. He who never learns to love the worship of God more than movies and ball games will never get to heaven. Feelings of envy, hatred, jealousy, and misuse of the tongue are all a part of the old life with its affections, not the new life with its affection.
