“And it came to pass, that when David was come to the top of the mount, where he worshipped God, behold, Hushai the Archite came to meet him with his coat rent, and earth upon his head: Unto whom David said, If thou passest on with me, then thou shalt be a burden unto me: But if thou return to the city, and say unto Absalom, I will be thy servant, O king; as I have been thy father's servant hitherto, so will I now also be thy servant: then mayest thou for me defeat the counsel of Ahithophel (II Samuel 15:32-35).”

“The Way” in Acts

Luke, the writer of Acts, has frequently used “the way” to describe Christianity. With him, it is “the way of life.” Before Saul’s conversion, he had received “letters to Damascus unto the synagogues, that if he found any that were of the Way, whether men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem” (Acts 9:2). This means that if he found any walking in the footsteps of Jesus, or living the Christian life, he would have them arrested and punish them for it. Again, Luke uses this expression as follows: “But when some were hardened and disobedient, speaking evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus” (19:9). Later on, the writer says: “And about that time there arose no small stir concerning the Way” (19:23). Later, when Paul was making a speech to the Jews, he said: “I persecuted this Way unto the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women” (22:4). Here the writer uses “the Way” to show that the persecution of Christians was the punishment for walking in “the Way.” Again, we have the term used by Paul in making his defense when Tertullus was charging him with being “a ring- leader of the sect of the Nazarenes” (24:5), in which he says: “But this I confess unto thee, that after the Way which they call a sect, so serve I the God of our fathers, believing all things which are according to the law, and which are written in the prophets” (24:14). Luke speaks of the knowledge of Felix: “But Felix, having more exact knowledge concerning the Way, deferred them, saying, When Lysias the chief captain shall come down, I will determine your matter” (24:22). This is the same as “the way of salvation” (16:17), or “the way of the Lord” (18:25).
