“WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHRISTIAN?: PART 1”

Every person has great events in life that mean so much more than everyday occurrences. They may include high school or college graduation, wedding day or the birth of a child. **But the most important event in one's life is conversion to Christ.** Other great events mean much but the effects are temporary. Becoming a Christian affects you and others **eternally**. What then does it really mean to become and be a Christian?

First, **becoming a Christian means that your past sins are forgiven.** Even those who crucified the Son of God could be forgiven (Acts 2:38). Saul of Tarsus was told to have his sins washed away, and that included killing Christians and otherwise persecuting the church. At this point God will treat you as if you had never sinned (Heb. 10:17). You are recognized by God as one of His children (2 Cor. 6:14-18). This results in a completely new and different relationship that provides strength (Heb. 13:5-6), brings about forgiveness of sins through repentance and prayer (1 John 1:9; Jam. 5:16), and provides a nearness to God otherwise unattainable (Jam. 4:8).

Second, **becoming and being a Christian means that you are not your own.** You now belong to God (1 Cor. 6:19-20). We can no longer do as we please and remain faithful (2 Cor. 5:15). Now that we belong to God we will never stop serving Him. He must always come first (Mat. 6:33; 26:39). Christianity is not a matter of occasional church services, but involves doing God's will in everything everyday (Rom. 12:11; Tit. 2:4-5; 1 Cor. 10:31).
