"THE SECOND LAW OF PARDON" BY: JASON GANN

I am very thankful for all of the principles and precepts found within the Holy Scriptures. It is wonderful to know that we have all things that pertain unto life and godliness (II Peter 1:3). Everything we need to know in order to have the best life here and the best life in eternity is found in the Holy Scriptures for they equip us for every good work (II Timothy 3:16-17).

One of the great teachings of Scripture, we call, "The Second Law of Pardon." You see, a person must hear the Word of God (Romans 10:17), believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God (Mark 16:16), repent of sins (II Peter 3:9), confess that Jesus is the Son of God (Matthew 10:32), and be baptized in the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38) to become Christians and be added to the Lord's church by the Lord Himself (Acts 2:47). Then, a Christian must live faithfully unto death (Revelation 2:10). What happens though if a Christian sins? This where the Second Law of Pardon comes into the forefront of our minds.

You see, as long as we are living faithfully, the Blood of Jesus Christ in which we have been washed to become Christians continues to cleanse of all of our past sins (I John 1:7). This verse teaches, "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." This requires walking in the light, you see. This means we must be living by the Gospel (II Corinthians 4:4), which was given by God (I John 1:5). The issue is that sin separates us from God, and when sin enters the picture, we must utilize the second law of pardon. Isaiah 59:2 teaches, "But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear."

The Second Law of Pardon denotes that God will offer pardon or forgiveness after one becomes a Christian, when a Christians goes astray. It is possible to fall from grace (Galatians 5:4). There is no such thing as "once saved, always saved" for that is a doctrine of the Devil. Simon, who was formerly a sorcerer, but who had become a Christian sinned in Acts 8. He is told what all Christians must be told when a Christian sins and that is to, "Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee." Repentance is a part of the Second Law of Pardon. This is turning from sin and turning back to God. Also, confession of sins is a requirement. I John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Prayer is another component of the Second Law of Pardon. A Christian who has gone astray, must return through repentance of sins, confession of sins, and prayer, and then, a Christian must live faithfully unto death (Revelation 2:10).

It is possible for a Christian to be lost. Remaining faithful is a requirement in order not to be lost. Be thankful for the Second Law of Pardon! Work to always remain faithful unto our God!
