"Prove All Things" BY: JASON GANN

In I Thessalonians 5:21, we are told, "Prove all things; hold fast that which is good." Let us take the time to look at what these 9 words mean to us. We are in these words told that we are to be examiners. We are to test all things. We are to then determine what is good and what is evil. The evil are to be rejected, but the good held onto with much fervency.

When we look at what to test that would be "all things." We are to examine. Any evil thing of which we take part can keep us out of Heaven for Revelation 21:27 and James 2:10 make it very clear that offending in one point will keep us out of Heaven, if we do not repent. Sin, by its definition, is the transgression of the Law of God. I John 3:4 says, "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law." We are going to be judged by the Law of Christ (John 12:48, Galatians 6:2). All things that pertain unto life and godliness are found in the Holy Scriptures, which equip us for every good work (II Peter 1:3, II Timothy 3:16-17). This tells me that we ought to examine everything in the Light of the Scriptures.

When we listen to preaching and teaching, we ought to look for a "Thus saith the Lord." In other words, that which is preached and taught should be backed up by Scripture (Acts 17:11). We cannot add to, nor take from God's Word (Galatians 1:6-9, Revelation 22:18-19). When we speak, we must make sure that what we say is the Truth always (Colossians 3:8-10). In everything we think, we ought to make sure that our thoughts are in line with righteousness (II Corinthians 10:3-6). In everything we do, we should make sure that we are being doers of the Word, and not hearers only, and abstain from all unrighteousness (James 1:22, I Thessalonians 5:22).

Let us follow Christ as our Pattern in all things (I Peter 2:21-24). If we would not think it, we should not think it. If we would not say it, we should not say it. If we would not do it, we should not do it. Let us hold onto that which is good, and bring forth spiritual fruit and enter Heaven in the end (Luke 8:15, Matthew 25:46)!
