## "PRAY FOR ALL: PART 5" BY: JASON GANN

In the fifth and final part of our study on "Pray for All," we are continuing to look at I Timothy 2:1-2. In part 1, we noticed that God wants us to pray and that there are different facets of prayer. In part 2, we studied about how that God wants us to pray for everyone. In part 3, we looked at how that God wants us to pray for our civil leaders. In part 4, we saw that Leading a quiet and peaceable life is desirable. Let us continue our study by looking at I Timothy 2:1-2 again. These verses say, "I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty."

Our lives should be in all godliness. My friends, we ought to pray for leaders to make those decisions that are going to allow us as the people of God to lead quiet and peaceable lives unto the Lord. We serve the God of peace (Romans 15:33). In the church we serve our Prince of Peace, Christ (Isaiah 9:6). We live by the Gospel of peace (Ephesians 6:15) and therefore, we must seek peace (I Peter 3:11). One way we do this is to pray for our leaders to make those decisions that are most needful to allow us to have no hindrances to living quiet and peaceable lives unto the Lord. Likewise, in living this kind of life, we ought to do so in all godliness. In other words, we ought to live in such ways as to be respectable. Later, the Holy Spirit inspire Paul to pen in Chapter 4, verse 8 of I Timothy that godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come. As faithful children of God, our lives are filled with the abundance of God's physical and spiritual blessings, including the forgiveness of sins, being able to pray unto God and have our prayers answered, fellowship with Him and our brothers and sisters, the peace that passes all understanding, and Heaven in the time to come (John 10:10, Acts 2:38, I Peter 3:12, I John 1:7, Philippians 4:4-7, Revelation 2:10).

**Our lives should be in all honesty.** We ought to live honorable, dignified, pure, and sanctified lives unto the Lord. The only we can do this is by having the Truth of God, His Word, ingrained within us, meditating upon each day and night, and obeying it (John 17:17, Psalm 1, II Timothy 2:15, Hebrews 5:9). We must speak this Truth unto others (Matthew 28:18-20). We ought not ever lie in our day to day conversation, also (Colossians 3:9-11). By people characterized by Truth and honesty, we bring glory to Christ (II Peter 3:18, Matthew 5:16).

I want to encourage each of us to make supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks for all men, for the rulers of this country and other countries, so that we, as Christians, may lead quiet and peaceable lives in all godliness and honesty. Our rulers have many challenges that they face. Let us pray for them each day, along with all men, that we all will be pleasing unto our Creator!
