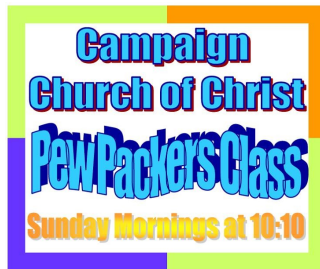

These things are good and profitable unto men.” “Affirm constantly” as used here is also found in I Timothy 1:7. This word in the original language of Greek for this text means “to affirm strongly” and “to assert confidently.” The Holy Scriptures equip us for every good work. We must do all we can to keep reminding our brothers and sisters in Christ to be careful to maintain good works. Any work not found in the Bible is not a good work. We must do what we are authorized to do in the New Testament, which is binding upon us today (Colossians 2:14, 3:17).

Friends, let us constantly be about the Lord’s work. Let us constantly hear the Truth and speak it. Let us constantly affirm the lessons of the Word of God. Let us constantly do good!

## “CONSTANTLY” BY: JASON GANN

Constantly. You have heard that word before, haven't you? Of course, you have! It is a word that we use from time to time. We all know what it means, don't we? It means with regular occurrence. One might constantly think something or constantly say something or constantly do something. This word is a familiar word. Did you know it is also in the Bible? This word in the English language is found one time in the Old Testament and two times in the New Testament.

**Speak Truth Constantly.** Proverbs 21:28 tells us, “A false witness shall perish: but the man that heareth speaketh constantly.” The word for “constantly” here is actually found in the original language of the Old Testament, that being Hebrew, in different ways, but this is the only time it is translated constantly. It refers to eminence, endurance, and everlastingness. This proverb tells us that a dishonest witness will perish, but a truthful man will continue. Colossians 3:9-11 teach us, “Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him: Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.” Revelation 21:8 teaches us, “But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.” We must speak truth, and be good listeners.

**Affirm Constantly as Did Rhoda.** In Acts 12, Peter is thrown into prison and is about to be put to death, but the angel of the Lord delivers him. He went to the house of Mary, the mother of John, where many were praying. There Rhoda comes to the door as he knocks. We are told in verse 15, “And they said unto her, Thou art mad. But she constantly affirmed that it was even so. Then said they, It is his angel.” The word for “constantly” here in the original language of Greek for this text is translated “confidently affirmed” in Luke 22:59. This means “to lean upon, affirm stoutly, and assert confidently.” Rhoda knows the Truth. She speaks it, despite what others say about her. Eventually, the others will believe the truth that Peter is at the door.

**Affirm Constantly: We Must Maintain Good Works.** Titus 3:8 says, “This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works.”
