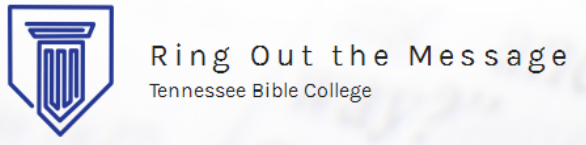

“DO NOT PARTAKE IN THE SINFUL WAYS OF THE WORLD”

I John 2:15-16 says, “Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.” Satan works to tempt people through the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life as I John 2:16 says. Christians must stand against the wiles of the devil each day we live upon the earth. In our effort to do this, it is important for us to remember the three avenues by which Satan tempts us.

In I Timothy 3:6, we are told that a man who seeks to be involved in the work of an Elder, but must not be a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of Satan. This tells me that through pride, Satan is condemned. God cannot create evil as James 1:17 teaches us. At some point, the Devil rebelled against God out of the Devil’s pride, and he became Satan. He has cunning devices (II Corinthians 2:11). I Peter 5:8-9 tells us, “Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.” We must constantly be on guarding against him. Romans 12:9 says, “Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.” We should abhor sin and cleave to that which is good. James 4:7 tells us, “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” Submitting to God, and resisting the Devil. This is so important.

I Corinthians 6:9-10 says, “Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.” I encourage you to live a life pleasing unto God each day by not partaking in the sinful ways of this world!
