There is no doubt the Bible sets forth the admonition to add the quality of self-control in our lives. We must master our body, not let our body rule over us. While the whole world follows the lust of their flesh, we choose to follow God's holy word and restrain from such lust. By the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, John was caused to write: "Love not the world, neither the things [that are] in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that [is] in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever" (1 John 2:15-17).

We are to control the spirit within us. "Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you" (Eph. 4:31-32). As Christians, we "...are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you" (Rom. 8:9). Proverbs also tells us: "[He that is] slow to anger [is] better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city" (Prov. 16:32). This is simply what Christians do.
