When men and women expose themselves in immodest apparel, such as swimming attire, clothing so tight as to accent the private areas of a person’s body, or sheer outer garments which expose the underclothing or body, or when they simply dress so scantily as to expose large areas of flesh, especially of the legs, midriff, back or chest, they commit the same error as did Adam and Eve, who sought to cover their nakedness, but who were in need of more attire.

Jesus said, “I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart” (Mat. 5:28). Some who wish to retain the liberty to dress as they please argue that the one after whom another lusts has no responsibility in the matter. While it is possible for one to lust after another who is properly dressed, will God hold us guiltless, if by our attire we entice another to lust after us? Jesus also said, “It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe unto him, through whom they come!” (Luke 17:1)!

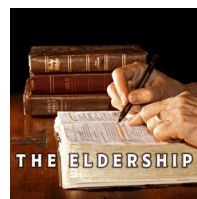
