“JAMES MCGILL (1931-2020)” BY: JASON GANN

Yesterday, I received sad news about the loss of a great man of God. A great Soldier of the Cross has left this world. He is a great and wonderful friend, named James “Jim” McGill.

Brother McGill graduated from Freed-Hardeman College (now Freed-Hardeman University) in 1950. He attended and graduated from David Lipscomb College (now Lipscomb University) with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1952. He continued his higher education at Peabody College of Vanderbilt University, where he earned the Master of Arts degree in 1954, the Specialist in Education degree in 1966, and the Doctor of Philosophy degree in 1970.

Brother McGill served as a teacher at Freed-Hardeman University from 1962 to 1977. He also taught at Tennessee Bible College for 20 years from 1980 to 2000. He served as Dean of Graduate Studies for the college. He was one of my teachers when I was a student there. Also, he served as Director of the Nashville School of Preaching for eight years. In 2002, he joined the faculty of the Middle Tennessee School of Preaching and Biblical Studies. He preached for churches of Christ in Jackson, Louisiana; Clinton, Tennessee; Corinth, Tennessee; Nuremberg, Germany; and Munich, Germany, most recently serving as preacher for the New Hope church of Christ in Nashville, since 2002.

Brother McGill was married to Nedra for 33 years until she passed away in 1988. They have two children and two granddaughters. He married Mora in 1997, and she has passed away, also.

I will always remember being in Brother McGill’s classes. It was a delight to sit before him and hear Bible lessons as he utilized his vast knowledge and vast memory. His memory always amazed me. He could tell you so many different accounts from church history and his life. He was truly a scholar in every sense of the word, who preached and taught the Truth. He was a meek and loving man, who fulfilled the words of I John 4:21, which says, “And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.” I cannot say enough good things about this great preacher of the Word. If you were not able to meet him in this life, then hopefully you will be able to meet him in a heavenly home. I know that brother McGill’s legacy will live on through the many preachers he helped to train, through the many that he influenced through his preaching and teaching, through his precious family, through the congregations and schools with which he labored.

He was almost 90, having preached for at or around 75 years. It was our great privilege to have him speak at the inaugural Bible Lectureship of the Campaign church of Christ in 2018. On that day, he preached that in order to seek God first in the church, the church must be a truly converted church, a reverent church, a united church, a sacrificing church that sacrifices financial means and time, a studying church, a working church, a praying church, and a worshipping church. *(Note: Article Continued on Page 3)*
