“DEMANDS OF DECENCY: PART 3”

Another area of modesty also involves our dress, but in this case not the amount of coverage, but the type of coverage. It is clearly the case that Paul and Peter in the passages mentioned were just as concerned, if not more so, about the type of clothing one might wear, as they were about the amount of clothing a person might wear. Christians are not to be adorned with “Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price” (1 Pet. 3:3-4).

Modesty demands that one dress appropriately for the occasion wherein he finds himself. Obviously, dress which is modest in one place may not be modest in another. For example modest sleeping attire would be immodest for entertaining guests, and clothing which is appropriate for digging a ditch would be inappropriate for a wedding or funeral. When brethren come together to worship their creator, modesty demands not only must we be fully clothed, but we must be dressed in a manner which demonstrates our respect unto God and one another. Consider two examples:

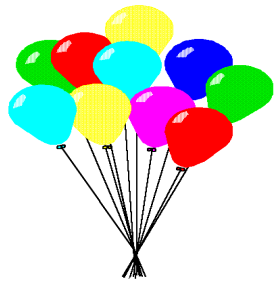

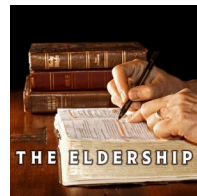
