Third, **let us learn to live one day at a time.** What is past cannot be changed. What is future is in the hands of God. We need to learn to live in the present tense and we will not be so tense. Jesus said: *"Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof"* (<u>Matt. 6:34</u>).

Fourth, **let us remember to "take it to the Lord in prayer"** — as the words of an old hymn state so well. If we would do this, it would lift many a burden from our shoulders. The Apostle Paul said: "In nothing be anxious; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God which passeth all understanding shall guard your hearts and thoughts through Christ Jesus" (<u>Phil. 4:6,7</u>). The Apostle Peter adds: "Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time: casting all your cares upon him; for he careth for you" (<u>1 Peter 5:6</u>).

Let us not shorten our lives or fail to enjoy everyday living because of needless worry. Let us trust our gracious heavenly Father to fulfill His promises to us.
