“DEMANDS OF DECENCY: PART 1”

“Decency” is defined as “the quality or state of being decent,” and “decent” in turn is defined as “conforming to standards of propriety, good taste, or morality; modestly clothed; free from immodesty or obscenity.” As standards are relaxed it becomes increasingly more and more difficult to distinguish modesty and obscenity, at least in the minds of many. However, since the bible commands us to be modest (1 Tim. 2:9), it is imperative that Christians have no such difficulty!

Paul exhorted the Romans. “And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God” (Rom. 12:2). The propositions of this passage are important: “be not conformed to this world”; “be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind.” Paul does not state to what one is to be “transformed,” but he implies that it is to that which is found in God’s Word. Christians are not to be overly swayed by the fashions of the world; they are to be adorned by their obedience to the commands which are found in the Bible. Peter and Paul both spoke concerning decent or modest apparel. In 1 Timothy 2:9-10, Paul said, “In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.”

Similarly Peter wrote to wives in 1 Peter 3:3-4, “Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.”

These passages show that one’s outward appearance is important, but that it is not to be considered as important as one’s inward image.

What then does it mean for one to be modest? First, to be modest one must be properly clothed; properly covered so as not to excite the lust of those who view one’s person

When God created Adam and Eve, “they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed” (Gen. 2:25). They were then in a state of innocence, but after their sin, “the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons” (3:7). This, however, was not acceptable unto God, so, “did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them” (3:21). So, we can see that from the beginning of time, God has required modesty of His subjects.
