**“PARTAKE OF GOD’S WORD, AND SPREAD IT”

God tells Ezekiel in Ezekiel Chapter 2, verse 4, “I do send thee unto them; and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD.” Everything that we preach and teach must be a “Thus saith the Lord GOD.” God warns him to not be afraid of the words of this most rebellious people to whom he would speak, though being among them would be like being among briars, thorns, and scorpions. He is prepared for his work by being told to eat what God gives him, so God gives unto Ezekiel a roll. Now this roll was not a bread roll that we love to eat at a restaurant with butter, but rather this was a scroll, which was spread before God. Verse 10 tells us that written therein were lamentations, mourning, and woe. In Ezekiel Chapter 3, then we find Ezekiel eating that roll. The message is clear as to why God would want him to eat this roll. He was to eat this roll and in so doing, he was to totally read and digest its contents. This roll was to become a part of his very person, who he was. He was to speak God’s Word, not his own. The roll was written on both sides, so there was no room for any additions by Ezekiel. Verse 3 indicates that it was in his mouth as honey for sweetness. Ezekiel is then told to go to the house of Israel and to speak to them. In verse 7, though Ezekiel is told to speak God’s Word unto Israel, he is told here, “But the house of Israel will not hearken unto thee; for they will not hearken unto me: for all the house of Israel are impudent and hardhearted.” God tells him that he has made his face strong against their faces and his forehead strong against their foreheads.

Now, even though we have been told by Jesus that the majority will not go to Heaven, we never-the-less have been told, like Ezekiel, to declare God’s Word unto them anyway. Jesus has told us in Matthew 28:19-20, “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world.” We can help the church to grow. True, the majority will not accept the church of the First Century, we know this upfront. Thanks be to God for telling us this upfront, so that we will not grow discouraged by seeing so many people reject the Gospel way of salvation. They reject it, because like those evil ones in Romans 1, they love pleasure more than God and they do not want to be told by anyone what to do, not even by God. They do not want to feel the guilt that comes with sin, so they have seared their consciences.

We are in the minority in a world estimated to be at over 7 billion people, with an estimated around 20,000 congregations of the church of Christ, and an estimated around 3 million Christians. We know that of this number less than 3 million would actually be faithful Christians, which we must be in order to be pleasing in the sight of God and in order to go to Heaven, Revelation 2:10. It is clear then that we are in the minority. We must do all that we can to influence them to accept the Gospel.
