“SIX THINGS YOU WILL NEVER REGRET”

- 1. **Showing kindness to an aged person.** “Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I am the Lord” (Lev. 19:32). “With the ancient is wisdom; And in length of days understanding” (Job 12:12). “Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, And despise not thy mother when she is old” (Pro. 23:22).
- 2. **Destroying a letter written in anger.** “Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:... Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you” (Eph. 4:26, 31-32). “A wrathful man stirreth up strife: But he that is slow to anger appeaseth strife” (Pro. 15:18).
- 3. **Offering the apology that saved a friendship.** “A soft answer turneth away wrath: But grievous words stir up anger” (15:1). “Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift. Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison” (Mat. 5:23-25).
- 4. **Stopping a scandal that would wreck a reputation.** “A prudent man concealeth knowledge: but the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness” (Pro. 12:23). “He that covereth a transgression seeketh love; but he that repeateth a matter separateth very friends” (17:9). “An hypocrite with his mouth destroyeth his neighbor: but through knowledge shall the just be delivered” (11:9).
- 5. **Taking time to show loved ones consideration.** “My son, hear the instruction of thy father, And forsake not the law of thy mother: For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, And chains about thy neck” (1:8-9). “But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel” (1 Tim. 5:8). “Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth” (Eph. 6:2-3).
- 6. **Feeling reverence for your maker.** “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: But fools despise wisdom and instruction” (Pro. 1:7). (Note: Continued on Page 4)
