"DEMANDS OF DECENCY: PART 4" BY: GIL YODER

When Moses approached the burning bush that attracted his attention from a distance, the first words of the Lord from the bush were, "Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground" (Exo. 3:5). The purpose for this instruction was that among the Eastern nations in the time of Moses wearing shoes in the presence of a superior was an indication of great disrespect (McClintock and Strong, Vol. IX, pp. 708f.).

Taking off the shoes, therefore, had the opposite effect. In the New Testament, Paul instructed Christian men and women as to the practice of wearing a covering in worship (1 Cor. 11:3-16). The very purpose for these instructions, whatever else may be said about the interpretation of the passage, was to encourage the brethren to dress so as to demonstrate their respect unto God and to one another. Surely we should be as careful in our dress as Paul expected the Corinthians to be in that time.
