# “THE LIGHT OF THE BODY”

Light is a glorious thing. We are told in Genesis Chapter 1, verses 3 through 5, that God created that which allows each of us to see through darkness. In the beginning, when God created the heaven and the earth, there was darkness. Then, with God’s Creative Power, He brought light into existence. We are told here, “And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.” Psalm 148 begins by telling us to praise the Lord, for the angels to praise the Lord, along with the sun and moon to praise Him. The heavens of heavens and waters above the heavens are told to praise him. Verse 5 says, “Let them praise the name of the LORD: for he commanded, and they were created.” All should praise God, yet before even the sun and moon and those innumerable stars that we see were created, God had already created this glorious thing called light. The sun and moon with the stars were created on the fourth day, while light was created on the very first day.

When we think of light then we should think more about it than simply that which radiates from the sun, moon, and stars. When we look at the definition of light, we see that we are told that it makes vision possible. We might even say that it is electromagnetic radiation that travels in a vacuum with a speed of about 186,000 miles per second, scientists say. Truly, when God separated the light from the darkness, we made the two total opposites.

In view of these things, let us reflect upon what Christ says in Matthew 6:22-23. He says, “The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!” Here, we are commanded to have our eye as single. In other words, our eye must be uncomplicated, and therefore, simple. It must be focused upon good, fulfill its work, and be sound (Luke 11:34). If our eyes focus upon light, then our whole body is full of light. If our eye is evil, then it is not fulfilling its function, and therefore we can only see darkness. It has been said that the eyes are the windows to the soul. Our souls make us who we are and will live on into eternity in heavenly reward or eternal punishment (1 Thessalonians 5:23, Matthew 25:46).

We then must make sure that our focus is on the Light. Our eyes must behold the good, not the bad. We must not have envious and covetous eyes (Proverbs 23:6, Mark 7:22). If the heart or the gaze of the soul is single, focusing on God and His Goodness, living out His will in our lives, then we will be filled with light. Our focus should be putting God First (Matthew 6:33). Our mission should be to fear God and keep His commandments, keeping in mind that by Christ’s Words we will be judged (Hebrews 13:21, Ecclesiastes 12:13-14, John 12:48). Ephesians 5:8-10, words it this way, “For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light: (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.” Let us live then as children of light. Let us be guided by the Word of God. Let us let it enlighten our lives and be a light unto our feet (Psalm 119:105).
