"PURE AND UNDEFILED RELIGION: PART 1" BY: JASON GANN

In II Thessalonians 1:8-10, our brother Paul informs us about that great Day of Judgment, in which Christ will return in the air. He describes how Christ will return, "In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day." Friends, if we are to make Heaven our home in the end, we must be totally obedient to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Our religion must be based upon the Truth, and be pure and undefiled. It must be lived.

All people have a religion. By this, I mean all have a belief system of some sort. Many people base their beliefs simply upon their own likes or what they have been taught by mortal people separate and apart from God's Word. True religion though is defined by God's Word. The Holy Scriptures contain all that pertains unto life and godliness, and they make us complete, thoroughly equipping us for every good work (II Peter 1:3, II Timothy 3:16-17). By them, we shall be judged (John 12:48). Christianity is the true and only religion to be a part of today (John 14:6).

When we consider what the Scriptures teach about our religion, we read in James 1:26-27 says, "[26] If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world." Here we find the word "religious" used, which means "fearing" and "worshipping" God. If anyone thinks of himself as fearing and worshipping God, if he bridles not his tongue, he deceives his own heart, for his religion is vain. His religion is worthless if he does restrain and check his tongue. His tongue is to be bridled. The ancient bridle was a loop on the halter-cord passed around the lower jawbone of the horse. Psalm 32:9 speaks of this for there we read, "Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee." Our tongue must be held in check as a horse's head is held in check upon riding.

James 3:3 says, "Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body." While horses and ships (James 3:4) can be turned about easily. While every kind of beasts, birds, serpents and things in the sea are tamed of mankind, yet the tongue can no man tame. James 3:8 says, ". . . it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison." It is very important that we say wholesome words. James 3:9-10 say, "Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God. Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be." Our tongues must be kept in check!
